**APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL CROP PRODUCTION INPUT ASSISTANCE TO SUPPORT EMERGING SEMI-COMMERCIAL GRAIN AND OILSEED PRODUCERS**

SACTA will consider applications from Service Providers acting on behalf of groups of farmers who require financial assistance for their input costs for the production of grains and oilseeds.

The financing of crop production inputs for emerging semi-commercial farmers fall under Enterprise Development in the Transformation Guidelines of the National Agricultural Marketing Council. This form only relates to applications submitted in terms of that category.

Successful Service Providers will be required to conclude a Service Level Agreement with SACTA, which stipulates the functions and responsibilities of the Service Provider. SACTA will also require a Tri-party Agreement to be concluded between SACTA, the Service Provider and each individual farmer who makes use of the financing scheme. Any financial assistance approved by SACTA will be fully repayable. A Business Plan for each farmer will form part of the Tri-party Agreement. Guidelines in respect of the information to be included in the Business Plan will be provided in the Agreement.
